



Ramsey Recycles!

Please **DO NOT**
Place Your Recyclables in Plastic Bags.

Ramsey has **SIMPLE SORT CURBSIDE RECYCLING** made available through ACE Solid Waste.

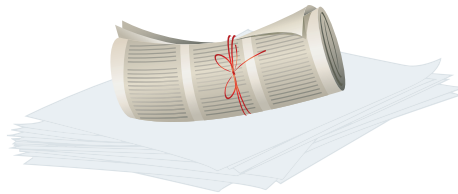
Place all acceptable curbside recyclables loose inside your Simple Sort cart. Recyclables need to be **empty, clean** and **dry**.

Do not place recyclables in plastic bags. Paper bags are okay. Contaminated recycling may not be collected.



PLASTIC BOTTLES AND JUGS

Soap, shampoo, lotion, detergent, water, soda, juice (empty and rinsed/clean, dry, with caps on)



PAPER

Mail, sheets of paper, magazines, catalogs, newspapers, circulars, phone books, paperback books (clean, staples are okay)



GLASS

Brown, green and clear bottles and jars (empty, rinsed, no lids)



CARTONS

Milk, juice, soup, broth, wine (empty, rinsed/clean, dry, with caps on)



METAL

Aluminum beverage cans, metal food cans (rinsed, labels are okay)



PLASTIC CUPS AND CONTAINERS

Yogurt, pudding, fruit, clear disposable beverage cups (no straws), margarine, whipped topping, cottage cheese, clear produce, clear deli and take-out containers (empty, clean, lids on)



BOXES - FLATTENED

Cardboard boxes (3x3 foot flattened bundle), cereal, cracker, cakes, pasta, tissue (no plastic), shoe, gift, appliance, toothpaste, toiletries boxes, and paper bags

Items **NOT** accepted through **SIMPLE SORT RECYCLING** are:

- Plastic bags and wrap
- Food waste and food tainted items—paper plates, bowls, pizza boxes, napkins
- Egg or ice cream cartons
- Aluminum foil, foil pouches, wrappers
- Colored plastic cups, utensils, straws
- Ceramic dishes, vases, mirrors
- Aerosol cans
- Styrofoam packing materials
- Plastic toys
- Garden hose, string lights, extension cords, chains
- Scrap metal
- Batteries, propane tanks
- Flower pots
- Wrapping or shredded paper
- Black plastics
