Bicycle Check Out Terms of Use

The City of Ramsey has FREE bicycles for Anoka County residents to use.

The system is simple and requires a one-time trip to Ramsey City Hall to read the terms of use, sign a corresponding liability waiver, and provide a copy of identification for record-keeping purposes. Once registered, you will be authorized to check out bicycles from the south side of the Municipal Parking Ramp. Bicycles may be used for exercise, recreation, and local business transportation purposes. Baskets, which can also be checked out and attached to the bicycles, can be used to cart items such as food for a picnic, beverages, or merchandise purchased at retail establishments in The COR.



Terms of Use

Users are mandated to wear appropriate headgear, follow basic safety rules, and be responsible for any minors in their custody. Keys must be obtained and returned at the reception desk on the first floor of the Ramsey Municipal Center between 8 a.m. and 4:30 p.m., Monday through Friday. Overnight use of bicycles is not allowed.

How it Works

- Pick up a key and helmet from the reception desk.
- Visit the bicycle rack on the bottom level of the Municipal Center Parking Ramp.
- Choose a bicycle from the available selection. The rack is stocked with three male adult bicycles of varying measurements and one adult woman's bike.
- Unlock the lock. Unwrap the security cable from the bicycle rack and take it with you to secure the bicycle to other area racks while shopping or conducting business.
- Adjust the seat for comfort.
- Put on your safety helmet.
- Enjoy you're ride.
- Return to the Ramsey Municipal Center when your outing is completed and replace the bicycle in the bike rack. Firmly replace the safety cable and securely fasten the lock.
- Double-check that the lock's pin has clicked and is secured. If the bicycle is lost or stolen, you will be charged with replacing it.
- Users are responsible for reporting any equipment problems or damage to the bicycles.
- Return the key and helmet to the reception desk.

Before using the bicycle checkout system, participants must read and understand the terms of use and sign the Voluntary Waiver of Liability Agreement for Bicycles.
