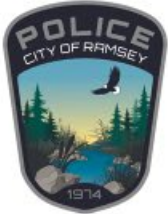

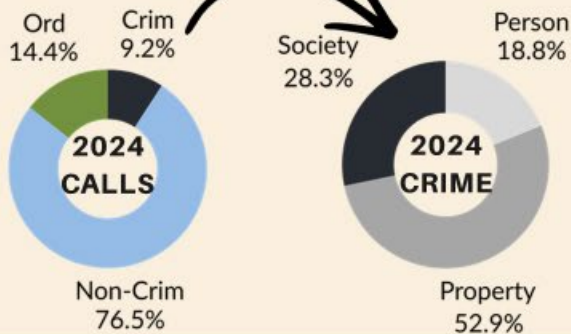

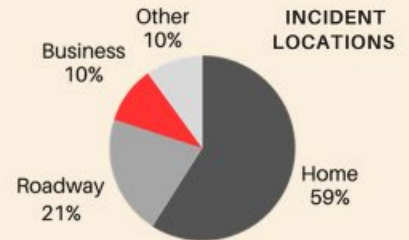
2024 OVERVIEW CITY-WIDE

- Historically, the top crime for Ramsey is Theft and the top non-criminal incident type is Medical



2025 OVERVIEW BUSINESS-RELATED

- 10% of calls occurred at a business
- Over 90% of calls to businesses were non-criminal



TOP 3 CRIMINAL INCIDENTS AT A BUSINESS

- 1 Theft (62 Cases)
- 2 Theft By Swindle (39 Cases)
- 3 HRO Violation (21 Cases)

TOP 3 NON-CRIMINAL INCIDENTS AT A BUSINESS

- 1 Medical (915 Cases)
- 2 Welfare Check (315 Cases)
- 3 Vehicle Lockout (191 Cases)

Public Safety



- Policing has shifted from simply retaining officers to supporting mentally healthy officers.
